JRS Lebanon provides quality education to vulnerable children by combining strong academic programming with active community engagement. Recognizing that learning thrives in supportive environments, JRS involves parents, caregivers, and local stakeholders to create a collective foundation for each child's success.

Holistic Learning Approach

JRS Lebanon delivers a high-quality, inclusive education program that responds to the diverse needs of refugee, migrant, and vulnerable Lebanese children. The approach is structured around a continuum of support that addresses different stages of a child's educational journey:

- **Community-Based Early Childhood Education and Care (CBECE):** Equips refugee and migrant children with foundational skills and school readiness, preparing them for entry into formal education.
- **Retention Support:** Provides academic and psychosocial support to help children remain engaged in formal schooling and reduce the risk of dropout.
- **Formal Education:** Ensures children complete certified educational programs, obtaining recognized qualifications that enable future academic or vocational growth.

Our learning centers serve as safe spaces where children can engage with education in a nurturing environment. These centers not only facilitate academic growth but also promote social inclusion, resilience, and overall well-being.
